Uniform Policy

It is important for our students to present an appropriate image through both appearance and behaviour - for their self-esteem, their sense of unity and for the reputation of the school. All students are expected to comply with uniform requirements.

Uniform and Appearance

Every article, including shoes, must be clearly marked with the owner's name.

A tidy and clean appearance is expected at all times. Pupils are encouraged to ensure that their clothing is in good order and that their shoes are clean.

- Girls: hair must be neat. Long hair should be held back from the face by a black coloured hair band / scrunchie.
- Boys: hair must be tidy and clear off the collar.
- Radical hairstyles and dyed hair are not acceptable.
- The wearing of make-up and nail varnish is not permitted.
- The only jewellery that may be worn at school is a watch and girls may wear one pair of ear studs or sleeper earrings. Religious symbols may also be worn but must be discreet.

Uniform Shop

The Elementary School uniform can be purchased from the on-site Uniform Shop which is open every Tuesday and Thursday during term time from 7:30am until 9:00am. The Uniform Shop accepts cash, credit card and NETS payments.

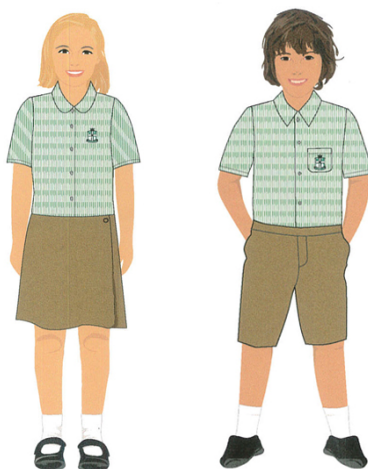

School Uniform

Prep 1 – Grade 6:

Children wear a striped school boy's shirt or girl's blouse, with the school crest embroidered on the pocket, with beige school bermuda shorts for the boys and beige skirts for the girls.



Shoes and socks:

Children are to wear white ankle socks and black closed-toe leather school shoes. Please note black runners and ballet flats are not acceptable.

Prep 1 and Prep 2 children also require a pair of wellington boots for wet weather play, which remain at school during term time.

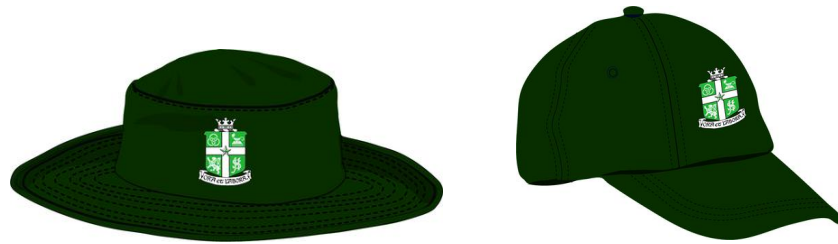
Pullover

Only school pullovers embroidered with the school crest are permitted to be worn with the school uniform. This is an optional item of uniform.



Sun Hats and Caps

The School adopts a strict '*no hat no play*' policy which means that children are required to wear the uniform sun hat or sports cap at play times and during all outdoor sports lessons.



Sports Uniform

All children wear a Lasallian House top and uniform green sport shorts. White sports socks and trainers of any colour are permitted.



The Lasallian house of each child will be advised upon enrolment; families are all in the same house.

Swim Kit

It is compulsory for all children to wear the unisex short-sleeved school rash vest with the matching swimsuit (girls) or jammer (boys).



School Sports Teams

If your child is selected to participate in any of the school's sports teams, the corresponding team uniform will be required. It will be made available to either purchase or loan from the schools PE department.

Sun Protection

The heat and sun in Singapore can be very intense all year round and in order to provide sun protection students are also advised to apply sunscreen lotion prior to school and at intervals throughout the school day. This is in addition to wearing the sun hat or sports cap. Students can keep a supply of sunscreen lotion in their classroom.

School Bags

School Library Bag

It is compulsory for all children from Prep 1 to Grade 4 have a school library bag. Without this library bag, children will not be able to borrow books from the library.



School Backpack

All children from Prep 1 to Grade 6 must have the compulsory school backpack. Two sizes are available to choose from.



Swim Bag

A gusseted bag with the school crest is a compulsory item for PE or swimming attire. It is made from water-resistant material, with drawstring straps.
